**Homeless Family Fund**

Our Fund helped a 24 year old mother with a 3 month old daughter referred by Haven House. She became homeless in August 2007 when she fled from Orange County after being severely abused by her boyfriend while she was pregnant. She filed a police report and left, breaking all ties with friends. She lived in a shelter in Fremont before entering Haven in January 2008. She was 7 1/2 months pregnant, had been in a car accident in December, and had a high risk pregnancy. She was connected with Prenatal to Three where she has received therapy and supportive services due to her exposure to abuse.

While at Haven she has applied for childcare and several jobs. She receives \$320 per month from TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families), \$100 per month in Food Stamps and milk and formula from WIC (Women With Infants and Children). She has part-time work babysitting for a friend 2 days a week earning \$240 per month and is waiting to hear about employment at Target where she worked for 2 years in Orange County.

She has secured a room to rent for \$500 per month and a friend is willing to help pay half until she can secure full-time employment to ensure that she has stable housing and does not continue to move from shelter to shelter with her newborn. Her total deposit was \$1,000. She had saved \$500 and our Fund sent the landlord the \$500 balance.

Today we must remember—we are necessary to others; our lives are not accidents—God has a purpose for each of us. Thank you for considering a donation to another's life.
