



## SOLEMNITY OF MARY, THE HOLY MOTHER OF GOD

JANUARY 1, 2020

New Year's Day is a Holy Day of Obligation. Our Mass schedule is as follows:

8:15 am 12:15 pm 7:00 pm

In the past some wanted to be content simply with the latter, but the Church has declared that Mary is the Mother of God. 


