## DOMINICAN SPIRITUALITY WITH FR. JAMES MOORE, O.P., PHD

Come and learn about the spirituality of the Dominican order. Dominican spirituality is theocentric, Christological, contemplative, monastic, priestly, apostolic, and doctrinal. Its first five qualities are common, but the apostolic and doctrinal character of Dominican spirituality is unique and specific among the various strands of Catholic spirituality. Dominican contemplation seeks to sanctify the individual and also to bear fruit in the apostolate, especially through preaching, teaching, and writing. Bring all your questions about the Dominicans since we've arrived at St. Raymond and Fr. James will be happy to share his expertise.



Fr. James was born in Coalinga, California and was ordained to the priesthood in 2008. A graduate cum laude of Santa Clara University in California, majoring in music, Fr. James earned his Master's degree in music from the University of Notre Dame in 2000, and his doctorate in Musical Arts (DMA) from the Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. in 2015. He now serves as the Vicar Provincial for Advancement for the Western Dominican Province.

Jesus’ message was not always comforting. But we are asked to honestly listen to His words and to do our best to carry them out, to love our neighbor, to care for the poor, and to be good stewards of our environment. None of this is easy, and real-life circumstances are often complex. For example, everyone wants clear air, but what if the actions we choose result in the collapse of several industries and the loss of millions of jobs, or in skyrocketing gasoline prices, or in cars priced beyond the means of the average laborer?

We don’t know all the answers, but we know we can all take actions to make things better by making personal choices that make a difference when we are joined by the actions of thousands of others.

- We can intentionally look to purchase goods that use less or no plastic despite the inconvenience.
- We can be more thoughtful about when and how we run our errands so as to use less gas.
- We can support legislation that protects the environment
