HALLOW APP REVIEW

I have been exploring the Hallow app, which was recommended to me by a priest after I expressed my struggle in finding time to further deepen my faith given my busy work and family schedule. In the last year, I've found Hallow to be exactly what I needed. Whether it's starting my day with the tenminute Daily Gospel reflections which set the tone for the day and give me something to think about during quiet moments between meetings, or the Morning Psalms, Daily Saints or Nightly Routine, the app offers meaningful guided short prayers for any time of day. And I've only begun to scratch the surface with respect to the app's various offerings. The homilies are also thought provoking and inspirational. I still want to try the music, novenas, and Bible stories. There's even something for children. This app has been a powerful tool, one that is helping me infuse my faith more fully into all aspects of my day to day activity. I don't know how many other parishioners have discovered Hallow, but I think almost all would benefit from it. It's particularly timely now as we are entering Advent. - Colleen Foraker

Pray * Dear Lord, please help me remember that no matter what happens today, where I am, who I am with, that I am standing in PEACE on Holy Ground. Remind me that all I am, have, see and breathe are from you, and to feel your JOY

Reflect * For me personally, when in nature, I feel very close to God. That is why it comes naturally to love the

earth and try to care for her. This has been true my whole life but even more intentionally since I joined Laudato Si'.

One day, I was having a hard day and went on a walk to think and pray. With nearly every step, the words echoed in my heart "You are standing on Holy Ground." I'd look around, see the beauty of creation, be filled with awe and JOY, and say in my heart, "Yes, Amen."



Act * Have you had an experience where you notice/ realize the beauty of creation and all the love our Lord gives us in it? Reflect and remember please.

Then ask yourself "what is one thing I can do to help protect this miraculous gift" and to say "thank you?"

- 1) If somewhere is close, walk instead of drive;
- 2) Use washable/reusable eating utensils instead of paper/plastic;
- 3) If you can no longer use an item, give it away rather than throw it away;
- 4) Pick up one piece of trash to protect the beauty of your "holy ground";
- 5) Smile when you see someone and add to the peace and joy of the world.

Now reflect again, please, on how many things you are already doing to help this beauty and see if you can add one more.
