- Double Red Cell Donation Power up your donation with an automated double red cell donation.
- Fast Track Donors can complete the health questionnaire online prior to arriving to the drive – visit <u>vitalant.org</u> and click the 'Health History Questionnaire' link (under Donate in the menu). The questionnaire must be completed the same day as the donation.




Fr. John is still at the Provincial Chapter at Saint Albert's in Oakland. He will be back in about two weeks when the chapter ends.

It has been 60 years since the "Environmental Movement" began.

• In 1969, the Cuyahoga River in Ohio was so contaminated

with oil leaks and industrial run off that it burst into flames.

• In 1972 the Clean Water Act was passed. Extensive clean up began and the river recovered.

Yet, Popes and Catholic teachers have been speaking out for centuries about our responsibility to care for creation.

Since the 60's, much progress has been made. Our sensibilities are heightened. When poisonous water supplies began to appear in 2014 in Flint River there were laws in place to hold those responsible accountable – but not without the hard work of concerned people. Many Christian groups had to stand up and give voice to the poor people of that community so they could get justice – and clean water. When we speak up for care of creation and take action, good results occur.

Two examples:

- Compelled by public pressure, USPS has announced that 50% of its new fleet of new mail vehicles will be powered by electricity.
- Locally, the Sonoma Creek Enhancement Project has turned a highly degraded mining area into a place where tides now freely flush out standing water, reducing breeding opportunities for mosquitos. Native vegetation and wildlife are returning.

Let us pray that we grow in love for God's creation and embrace ways to care for it.
