



## **BLESSING OF THROATS**

Friday, February 3rd is the feast of St. Blaise. He was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. Very little is known about his life. According to various accounts he was a physician before becoming a bishop. His cult spread throughout the entire Church in the Middle Ages because he was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the eighth century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat.

Blessing of throats will be offered at the end of the 8:15 am Mass.

### THE GREEN POPE

Pope Benedict XVI:

"Respect for creation is of immense consequence, not least because 'creation is

the beginning of the foundation of all God's works,' and its preservation has now become essential for the pacific coexistence of Mankind." (2010 World Day of Peace letter). As January comes to an end, I wanted to reflect on the beautiful life of Pope Benedict, who was an amazing example of courage, integrity, and deep abiding love for God.

He told us, "God gave men rule as steward ... with responsibility over creation, a role which men must certainly not abuse, but also one which he may not abdicate."

In his Laudato Si' encyclical, Pope Francis often said that Pope Benedict inspired him in his advocacy for the environment.

Pope Benedict emphasized the environment as a gift from God. He said, "its protection in the present and conservation for the future are a moral requirement". He also counseled that we must "renew that covenant between human beings and the environment, which should mirror the creative love of God, from whom we come and towards whom we are journeying."



Let us live our lives inspired by Pope Benedict's words and example.
