## EVERY DAY IS EARTH DAY

Sometimes it seems that people are too divided to agree on anything, but for decades there has been broad agreement that we need to do more to protect the environment. Of course, our Popes as far back as Saint Pope John Paul have urged greater care for creation. But can you guess which president said this?

“We have too casually, and for too long abused our natural environment...we can wait no longer to begin to repair the damage and establish a new criterion to guide us into the future. The tasks that need doing require ingenuity, resolve, and money, and are too big to be done by government alone. They call for...greater citizen involvement and new programs to ensure that government, industry, and individuals are called to do their share of the job and pay their share of the cost.” It was Richard Nixon in 1970.

In today's readings, Peter challenged his readers to be living stones of the church, that is, to open themselves to be a dwelling place for God's own spirit. In the Gospel Jesus tells us how. HE is the way the truth and the light. We must submit to living as He did, with unconditional concern for others, and the rejection of self-centeredness. Jesus dedicated his life to others. Like the apostles in Acts, we must be willing to change our attitudes so as to live like Jesus did, caring for others, especially the poor and vulnerable. In *Laudato Si'*, Pope Francis reminds us that it is the vulnerable who most suffer the impacts of climate change and he offers us a vision that encourages us to participate in the urgent work of rescuing our planet as a matter of loving justice. As individuals and as a Catholic community, we can make a difference. As people of faith and followers of Jesus, we must.

You can support this rescue effort by urging your elected officials to promote environmental justice, and by supporting groups that advocate for climate protections.
