IT'S ROSARY SUNDAY!

Praise God, vocations to the Dominicans in the West have grown 35% over the past decade! This week is our annual *Rosary Sunday: Dominican Student Appeal*, which supports the formation of the 42 young men currently preparing to be your future Dominican priests and religious brothers.

As the Dominicans do not receive any funding from the diocese for the formation of their brothers, your support of the appeal is critical and deeply appreciated. Without God's grace and your help, their formation would not possible.

Formation takes about eight years, and costs approximately \$59,500/year per student brother - or \$163/day. That investment includes a graduate education, housing, food, travel expenses, as well as their healthcare. Your gifts are stretched far!


The Greatest

THINKING ABOUT BECOMING CATHOLIC?






MINISTRY TO THE SICK


